S. 216th Street Segment 1-A will be widened to create a “complete street” and principal arterial serving motorized and non-motorized travel modes. This is the last ¼ mile Transportation Gateway project segment which has been fully designed, reviewed and environmentally cleared for right-of-way acquisition. The project provides roadway capacity to support infilling and economic redevelopment of under-utilized urban properties, provide congestion relief, formalize a Gateway entrance to the City’s downtown, serve as a new south access connection to Sea-Tac International Airport, and support the new S. 200th St Link rail station.
