The project consists of replacement and upgrade of aging and undersized sewer mains installed 30 to 50 years ago. These sewer mains are in three locations all near the Nooksack River, which is under a Total Maximum Daily Load for Fecal Coliform. The sewer pipes are concrete tile and are prone to leaking and to infiltration and inflow. All of these sewer mains are identified in the Sewer Comprehensive Plan as needing replacement as well increase in capacity to accommodate peak flows and future growth in the next six years.
