Yew Street's condition is severely deteriorating and it has no storm drainage system. The Project will reconstruct approximately 1,300 feet of new street with related sidewalks and stormwater facilities including rain gardens. In addition, a 2,000 foot storm drain trunk line is proposed to provide the necessary outlet for the project drainage. The project construction documents are 95% complete. SEPA has been determined and NEPA is near determination. Readiness is a matter of a few weeks. This project will improve the access to the Central Business District by providing sidewalk that connects to the Central Business District. In addition, bike lanes will be added. The bus routes on Yew Street proceed directly to stops in the Central Business District.
