This project will increase the solids handling capacity of the Lakota Wastewater Treatment Plant in compliance with the District's National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit. The improved digesters will be able to handle the higher density sludge and provide enough detention and treatment time in the digesters to continue producing Class B biosolids that can be used as a land applied fertilizer.
