This project consists of the replacement of existing aged and severely deficient water mains in the City's water system. The water mains are located both within City limits and in an outside service area to the south called Seaview. The project will replace approximately 11,000 linear feet of asbestos cement and galvanized steel water pipe with new eight inch diameter C900 PVC water main.
