The “Main Street” Reconstruction Project is a multimodal project that will reconstruct a seriously degraded, 50+ year-old arterial street system, improve sidewalks, add bicycle facilities, and provide a safe, walkable urban environment within the City’s Town Center, using a Complete Streets approach. It will improve regional mobility and connectivity by encouraging housing and job creation near substantial, existing transit infrastructure along the Interstate-5 highway corridor. This project will create 188 immediate jobs, attract significant development, and encourage economic development.
