

PWTF Pre-Construction Loan Program

The 2012 Legislature appropriated \$3M for the PWTF Pre-Construction Program. The Public Works Board provided financing to 13 local governments to move their projects from concept towards construction.

The City of Quincy's Pre-Construction loan will allow the City to move toward completion of the design of the Reverse Osmosis system. The preconstruction activities being done for this project include: Final design and bid services, preparation of a 60 percent design review submittal, pre-design report for regulatory review, bid drawing set and specifications package, permitting and approval, services during bidding and award, and public involvement.



A Pre-Construction loan financed land and right-of-way acquisition for the City of Camas' NW Friberg Street and Goodwin Road Improvements. The new roadway will include one lane in each direction, a common left turn lane, bike lanes, sidewalks; and storm water collection, treatment, and detention.
