

Washington Infrastructure Information Portal (WIIP)

It's been 13 years since an assessment of infrastructure needs has been conducted state-wide and typically the data is outdated as soon as the report is published.

DEMONSTRATION PROJECT

The Public Works Board has sponsored a demonstration portal to collect data on local government infrastructure needs. This prototype includes a reporting function and a mapping feature, and is designed to be adapted from existing software products. \$250,000 to complete this prototype is included in Governor Inslee's 2014 Supplemental Operating Budget request (HB 2185 / SB 6002).

Three options to view project data:

- (1) Scroll down the page to select the jurisdiction you are interested in.
- (2) Hover your mouse over a project number on the map.
- (3) Type in a jurisdiction name plus "WA" in the search bar.
